



MATERIALS: chocolate cookie (soft cookies work best), toothpick, tweezers, excavating mat

Observel

- I. Place the cookie on your excavating mat on grid A. Note the coordinates of the top, bottom, and sides of the cookie.
- 2. Sketch the perimeter of your cookie on grid B and sketch the chips that are visible on the surface.
- 3. Predict how many chips you'll find.

Excavate

- Using a toothpick to excavate (remove) the chocolate chips from your cookie without damaging them. Challenge: Try not to pick up your cookie while you are excavating!
- As you remove each chip, use your tweezers to carefully place them in a safe location while you continue to excavate. Sketch each chip on grid B as you find them.


